

Bikeshare in Indy!

What is a Bikeshare?

Bikeshare is a bicycle sharing system where bicycles are available for shared use to individuals for a small fee on a short term basis.

When will Bikeshare start?

The anticipated start of the bikeshare program is May, 2014.

How will I use the Bikeshare here in Indy?

Typically, bikeshare programs have 24 hour, 3 day & annual memberships available to residents & visitors. You can sign up online or at a bikeshare station kiosk. After becoming a member, you are able to check out a bike for a small fee, use it for an allotted period of time and then check it back into one of the many stations available. Once the initial period of time has passed, additional charges may apply, but your “free” time always starts over once you check your bike back into a station.

You may use the Bikeshare program to commute to and from work, for everyday errands, to show friends, family & visitors around our City, or just to enjoy getting around Indy by bicycle. Use it however you like!

How large will the Indianapolis Bikeshare system be?

The Indianapolis Bikeshare system will have approximately 300 bikes & 25 stations.

Where will the stations be located?

Bikeshare will be located in downtown Indianapolis with the majority of stations being located near the Indianapolis Cultural Trail. The public is invited to give input on the station locations by attending a public meeting [June 27, 12:30 - 2:30pm & July 10, 5:30 - 7:30pm at 202 East Market Street] or providing input online at indyculturaltrail.org.

How is the system funded?

The initial equipment for the system is funded by a federal grant. Memberships, user fees & sponsorships will fund the ongoing operation of the Bikeshare program. Ongoing funding for the system is the responsibility of Indianapolis Cultural Trail, Inc. (ICT, Inc.).

Who will operate the Bikeshare program?

ICT, Inc., the nonprofit responsible for ongoing management of the Cultural Trail, will operate the bikeshare program.
