Line Up Announced for Third Week of *Swish* Live Music and Performances Along the Indianapolis Cultural Trail; Almost 80 performances from local artists

INDIANAPOLIS - Indianapolis Cultural Trail Inc today announces the lineup for the third week of *Swish* Live, a music and performance series on the Indianapolis Cultural Trail: A Legacy of Gene and Marilyn Glick and downtown's civic spaces during March and early April. The third week includes almost 80 performances with many more to come in the following weeks.

Swish Live includes a diverse lineup of Indy's top performance talent that will bring the city's outdoor civic spaces to life. *Swish* Live is one of the components of the [Swish](#) arts and cultural experiences which kicked off March 13 in downtown Indianapolis.

"*Swish* Live is the perfect opportunity to highlight the richness and diversity of Indianapolis musicians and performance artists while providing paid opportunities for local creative professionals," said Kären Haley, executive director, Indianapolis Cultural Trail Inc. Swish will shine a spotlight on the city's creative talent as the city welcomes all 68 NCAA men's basketball tournament teams and fans from across the nation, while employing central Indiana artists who have lost significant income during the pandemic due to event cancellations and venue closures. The Arts Council of Indianapolis put out a public call for artists in February, and received more than 560 submissions. *Swish* is funded through a Lilly Endowment Inc. grant received by Indiana Sports Corp to create a safe, welcoming environment for local residents and visitors during the tournament.
